RULES

Pools A, B and C will play at Penncrest High School. Pool D will play at Penn State Brandywine.

Pool Play: 2-21 point games. Start at 4, cap at 27

Top 2 teams in each pool advance to playoffs

Ties for playoff positions will be determined by overall record, head to head competition and then point differential.

No team will be eliminated based on point differential.

If a deciding game is needed to determine second place, it will be one game to 15, no cap.

The 3rd place team in each Pool must stay and work the quarterfinal match on their court. You will not be invited back if you leave without working. Check with the manager if you are unsure of your place in the pool.

PLAYOFFS

Playoffs are best of 3. First 2 games to 21, third game to 15. Rally scoring, no cap.

We will start playoffs as soon as pool play is done.

The first place team from Penn State will stay for Quarterfinals, and the second place team from pool C at Penncrest will go to Penn State. The winning team will immediately report to Penncrest for the Semifinals.

Teams that lose in the Quarterfinals on Courts A and B will stay and work the Semifinals.

Finals are the best of 3, first 2 games to 25, third game to 15. Rally scoring, no cap.

Officials will work the finals!

INFORMATION

Coaches: There will be folders for each team located at the score table on your court. These will have any additional information that you may need, as well as line up cards for your matches.

Teams may set up camp in the hallway on the 1st or 2nd floor at Penncrest (not in the gym upstairs). Teams going to Penn State can set up in the cafeteria. Please make sure your teams have cleaned up their area before they leave for the day!

A trainer will be available all day.

There will be a full concession stand at Penncrest. Because of Penn State's food regulations, only drinks and snacks will be sold at Penn State. Lunch will be available at Penncrest and it is a very short distance. Teams playing at Penn State should however decide if you want your players to pack a lunch!!
